
ABOUT THIS TOOLKIT

Young people were asked 4 questions as a guide but the direction each session went varied depending on the group. The questions considered were:


- 1 WHEN I HEAR THE WORDS TRANSPORT SERVICES WHAT DO I THINK?

- 4 WHAT DO YOU WANT PROFESSIONALS TO DO TO IMPROVE TRANSPORT SERVICES?






WHEN YOUNG PEOPLE HEAR THE WORD 11 TRANSPORT (NAME OF THE WORD)

Nonverbal or anxious people may not be able to communicate with the drivers






WHAT CAN PROFESSIONALS DO TO IMPROVE TRANSPORT SERVICES FOR YOUNG PEOPLE?


